PURPOSE, LEGAL BASIS OF DATA PROCESSING AND LEGITIMATE INTEREST

The data provided by you within the application sent to us, such as name, address, job and email, will be stored and processed by us for the purpose of checking your suitability for the position (possibly other open positions in our company) and to carry out the application procedure.

The Processing for the above reasons is based on § 26 BDSG. Should your data be necessary for legal action, the processing will be also based on a legitimate interest (Art. 6 (1) Lit f GDPR).

IS THE PROCESSING A STATUTORY OR CONTRACTUAL REQUIREMENT?

The provision of personal data is neither required by law nor by contract. However, it is not possible to process your application without this information.

RECIPIENT OF THE DATA

Within our company, HR reviews applications and forwards suitable candidates to the responsible department head. Only individuals involved with your application will have access to your application data.

DATA TRANSMISSION TO THIRD COUNTRIES / INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATIONS

Under normal circumstances, an applicant's information will not be transmitted outside of the European Union.

DURATION OF STORAGE

Should you become an employee of Xantaro Deutschland GmbH, we will continue to use your data for personnel purposes. Otherwise, your data will be deleted after 6 months.

YOUR RIGHTS AS A DATA SUBJECT

As a data subject, you have the right of access under Article 15 GDPR, the right to rectification under Article 16 GDPR, the right to erasure under Article 17 GDPR, the right to restriction of processing under Article 18 GDPR, the right to object under Article 21 GDPR and the right to data portability under Article 20 GDPR.

Restrictions according to §§ 34 and 35 BDSG apply to the right of access and the right to erasure.

In addition, you can complain at any time to a supervisory authority.

RIGHT OF OBJECTION

Information on your right of objection under Article 21 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

You have the right to object at any time to the processing of personal data concerning you for reasons arising from your particular situation.

If you object, we will no longer process your personal data, unless we can prove compelling reasons worthy of protection for the processing, which outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms, or the processing serves to assert, exercise or defend legal claims.
